

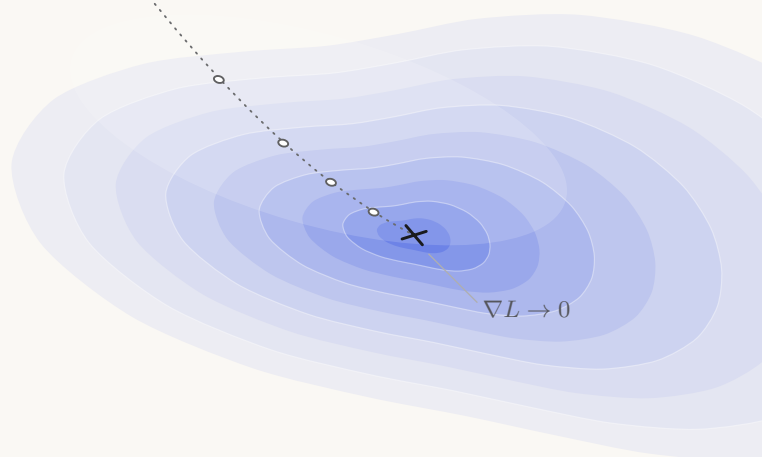

Ambassador Activities

Below is a list of suggested activities for IMLC Ambassadors. These ideas can support your outreach efforts. Be sure to document and submit your actions through your Ambassador account. You're also welcome to explore additional initiatives beyond this list.

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| ACTION
01 | Promote IMLC on Social Media
Help spread awareness by sharing official IMLC posts and information across platforms such as Facebook and Instagram. Tag the official pages to help increase visibility. |
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| ACTION
02 | Add Your IMLC Ambassador Role to Profiles
Display your IMLC role proudly on your social and professional platforms like LinkedIn or Facebook. You can include a link to your ambassador profile. |
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| ACTION
03 | Share IMLC with Friends and Classmates
Talk to peers in your school, university, or community about IMLC, explaining what the competition is and why it's exciting. Encourage them to participate. |
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| ACTION
04 | Talk to Teachers and Coordinators
Introduce IMLC to teachers, club mentors, and school officials. Provide information about the educator platform and special awards for schools. |
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| ACTION
05 | Present IMLC in Classes or Clubs
Give a brief presentation about the competition during a class session or club meeting to spark interest among students. |
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| ACTION
06 | Distribute Posters and Flyers
Print and hang official IMLC posters at school, community centers, or libraries to attract attention. Digital copies can be found on the IMLC website. |
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| ACTION
07 | Start a Machine Learning Club or Group
Form a group at your school to explore machine learning problems together, host problem-solving sessions, or use IMLC problems to build engagement. |
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ACTION 08	Organize Machine Learning Workshops or Events Plan events like problem-solving workshops, project showcases, or Q&A sessions where you introduce IMLC and machine learning topics in an interactive way.
ACTION 09	Create a Local Social Media Group Establish a local WhatsApp or Facebook group for your school or city to coordinate IMLC efforts and share updates.
ACTION 10	Collaborate with Local Organizations Work with local clubs, academic hubs, or institutions to promote IMLC or co-host events that highlight the importance of machine learning.
ACTION 11	Share IMLC through Newsletters or Blogs Submit a short article about IMLC to your school's newsletter, student blog, or internal communication platforms.
ACTION 12	Encourage Other Schools to Join Extend outreach to other schools or universities in your area. Offer to share materials or connect them with the IMLC organizing team.
ACTION 13	Arrange Local Meetups Organize informal meetups for interested students to discuss machine learning topics and learn more about the competition together.
ACTION 14	Support the Qualification Round at Your School Coordinate with teachers to hold a scheduled Qualification Round session and assist participants in preparing and submitting their solutions.
ACTION 15	Represent IMLC at Local Events If your school or city hosts academic fairs, science fests, or STEM days, represent IMLC by setting up a booth or delivering a short talk.
ACTION 16	Inspire Through Your Own Participation Lead by example: participate actively in IMLC and share your journey and insights with others to motivate them.
